1. UNDER WHAT CIRCUMSTANCES DO WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

We share your personal information with third parties where necessary to fulfil the purposes identified above, and more specifically, as set forth in the table below:

Categories of Third Parties	Purpose of Communication
Service providers	We may provide your personal information to companies that provide services to help us with our business activities, such as by submitting email communications to you on our behalf. These companies are authorized to use your personal information only as necessary to provide these services to us.



Business partners	EBlock may partner with select retailers and other companies at various times to provide expanded services to our site visitors. As part of such a relationship, we may share with these companies the use of certain interactive Web site functions (e.g., when registering for events). Data/information provided by site visitors through such interactive functions may be available to both EBlock and our partners. In addition, note that such third parties may provide access to additional privacy policies related to the service, which should be reviewed by you.
Professional advisors	We may disclose your personal information to our legal, financial, accounting or other consultants to the extent necessary to operate our business and comply with applicable laws.
Law enforcement & Other government agencies	To comply with legal obligations and respond to lawful requests. We verify that the request is legitimate before responding.
Successors in interest	In the event of a sale, merger, or other business transaction, to enable the new owner or operator of our Website to continue providing services to our users.



1. COOKIES

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device when you access our website, and they can be used to collect information such as your browser type, IP address, and pages visited on our site. EBlock uses cookies to conveniently allow you not to re-enter data/information, such as your contact details, multiple times during your visits to our Web sites. Cookies can also help us provide data/information targeted to your interests based on your prior browsing on our Websites. Cookies also help us to detect bugs and errors on our Sites.

You can manage your cookie preferences by adjusting the settings in your web browser. Please note that disabling cookies (such as essential or functional cookies) may limit your ability to use certain features of our website. Despite this, you can disable cookies in your browser at any time.

Cookie preferences must be set for each Internet browser. 1. BROWSER-BASED DO NOT TRACK

1. HOW DO WE STORE AND SECURE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Your personal information is hosted on the servers of our trusted service provider located in the United States of America. You consent to transfer information to jurisdictions outside of your province or country of residence, which may have data protection rules different from those in your province or country of residence. We retain your personal information only for as long as necessary to fulfil the relevant purposes specified in this Policy and comply with our legal obligations. 1. CHILDREN'S PRIVACY
